DIRECTOR'S NOTES

In 1994, Gay Times editor Peter Burton contributed to "Drag: A History of Female Impersonation in the Performing Arts." In it, he criticized the depiction of drag in film: "Most films which use drag as a plot component, use it as a comic device: a man in a frock is still seen as inherently comic. [...] Nor do I think that an increased incidence of drag in movies implies that traditional views of masculinity are changing because almost invariably films about [...] cross-dressing are about individuals forced by circumstances to cross-dress and triumphing against their circumstances because they are really men. And if men's traditional roles are actually being reinforced by films in which they dress as a woman (*Tootsie, Mrs. Doubtfire*), this implies that there's no change as far as tolerance of acceptance or difference is concerned."

Also in 1994, an independent film called *The Adventures of Priscilla, Queen of the Desert* came out of Australia. It featured three drag queens (two men and one transgender woman) who take a literal and metaphorical journey, using drag not as a way to reinforce traditional masculinity by contrast, but rather as a celebration of humanity in its many different forms.

In 2006, Stephan Elliott and Allan Scott adapted this story as a stage musical, marrying this story of humanity with the artistic spectacle of 70s to 2000s-era drag performance, integrating some of the hugest musical hits of those decades. The result is a show that has a ton of heart, challenges traditional notions of gender and sexuality, and accomplishes this without ever losing sight of its goal to entertain.

Given all this, it has been an absolute honour to get a chance to bring this show to FRC's stage. My goal in directing the show has been to try, as best I could, to listen to others' experiences and figure out how to bring those to this show. Rather than pretending this is my story to tell, I wanted to integrate as many voices, backgrounds, and experiences as possible. And I have been lucky enough to be surrounded by a team on and offstage who have risen to the occasion, bringing life to this show in the characters, the costumes, the makeup — all the elements. It's been amazing to see people approach this show as a labour of love, and I couldn't be happier or more excited for you to see it!
